

### Q1 How long have you been familiar with Nonprofit Network?

# Q2 In the past five years, what Nonprofit Network services have you taken advantage of? (Please check all that apply)







# Q6 What is the primary reason you are not currently involved in a membership with Nonprofit Network?





### Q7 What is your local Capacity Building Center called?





### Q12 Which race best describes you?




